Section 22 Amendment

As an option as part of the Appeal process, MWCC has lodged an Amendment to our Development Application in a bid to alleviate a number of reasons for refusal by the Hobart City Council. MWCC are confident these should also address additional formal issues raised by various parties to the Appeal.

Physical amendments are limited to a footprint reduction of the Pinnacle Centre.

Operational amendments will see the removal of the fine dining restaurant and sanctum viewing room, a reduction in operational hours and a reduction in the maximum capacity (50%) of the aerial tramway cabins.
